NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, hereby calls for and request sealed bids for the following materials to be purchased by said BOARD for and on behalf of LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Furnishing the following materials for the period beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019.

The bidder shall state in his bid that the unit price quoted shall be firm for the period stated above.

Each bidder must state price per ton for materials advertised herein.

Materials must meet current Florida Department of Transportation specifications.

Levy County reserves the right to accept multiple bids. Through feasibility assessment Levy County will then choose the vendor that provides the best benefit to the County, for each individual project.

Payment shall be made according to the actual number of tons delivered as specified herein.

All prices shall be FOB, LEVY COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT, BRONSON, FLORIDA.

Deliveries shall be made in such quantities as designated by the LEVY COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT.

Bids shall be in duplicate, sealed in an envelope and clearly marked BIDS ON ASPHALT."

Bids/proposals will not be accepted without this completed form.

The BOARD reserves the right to waive any informality in any bid, to accept and/or reject any or all bids in whole or in part, with cause, and accepts the bid that in their judgment will be in the best interest of LEVY COUNTY.

I understand that a "public entity crime" as defined in paragraph 287.133(1)(a), Florida Statutes, mean a violation of any state or federal law by a person with respect to and directly related to the transactions of business with any public entity or with an agency or political subdivision of any other state or with the United States including, but not limited to any bid or contract for goods or services to be provided to any public entity or any agency or political subdivision of any other state or of the United States and involving antitrust, fraud, theft, bribery, collusion, racketeering, conspiracy, or material misrepresentation.
3. I understand that "convicted" or "conviction" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(b), Florida Statutes means a finding of guilt or a conviction of a public entity crime, with or without adjudication of guilt, in any federal or state trial court of record relating to charges brought by indictment or information after July 1, 1989, as a result of a Jury verdict, nonjury trial, or entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere.
4. I understand that an "affiliate" as defined in paragraph 287.133(1)(a), Florida Statutes, means:
 1. A predecessor or successor of a person convicted of public entity crime; or
 2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of a public entity crime in Florida during the preceding 36 months shall be considered an affiliate.
5. I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with the legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or applies to bid on contracts for the provision of goods or services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
6. Based on information and belief, the statement which I have marked below is true in a relation to the entity submitting this sworn statement. (Please indicate which statement applies).
